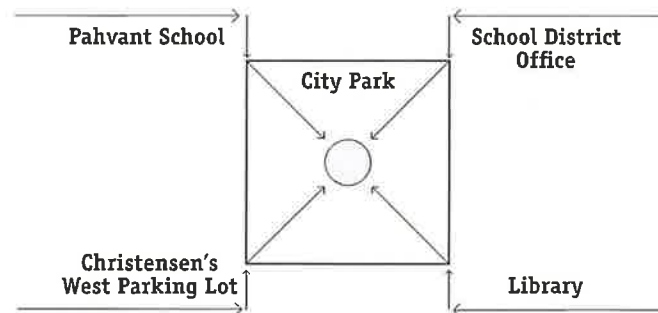


Christmas Carol Processional
